Dean D. Russell was born in Lake City, Florida, USA educated at the University of Oregon, graduating with a Master of Architecture and at Portland State University, graduating with a Bachelor of Science in Architecture. An architect with the Alberta Association of Architects, Architectural Institute of British Columbia and maintains reciprocity across Canada, he is a member of the Royal Architectural Institute of Canada, an active role with the Edmonton Art and Design Council, RAIC Syllabus Program and a member of the Heritage Resource Review Panel. Mr. Russell has had extensive experience in Alberta and along the West coast of North America during and since his graduation. In Oregon he was involved primarily with downtown urban planning programs for universities and other public institutions. In Europe and North Africa he was involved in a sabbatical study with the Portland State University department of architecture an international lecture series reflecting historical movements. Since his return to Canada, Mr. Russell has continued to be involved with planning and architectural studies with award winning firms of thirty or more years in the City of Edmonton and across Canada.

Prior to establishing the firm of Russell Architecture Ltd. Mr. Russell brings 15 years experience and a wide diversity of projects completed both individually and as a member of interdisciplinary design teams. He is a member with the Canadian Green Building Council - Alberta Chapter for sustainable buildings - Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design (LEED) Canada's Green Building Rating System. Dean is involved in the Heritage Resource Review Panel for the City of Edmonton. The review panel designates and establishes planning principles for the restoration of provincial and municipal registered buildings and neighborhoods. The panel also designates building or neighborhood components that hold historic significance.
